WEATHER FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND TOMORROW 30TH JULY, 2024 SYNOPSIS AND INFERENCE:

Expect sunny, hazy and hot conditions due to the influence of warm easterly air mass.

WARNING: Mwera winds with speed of up to 35km/h are expected to blow on Lake Malawi and Lake Chilwa from Wednesday evening, 31st July 2024 to Saturday afternoon 3rd August, 2024. The Mwera winds are likely to cause high water waves of 1 m.

SHIRE VALLEY (areas along Shire River and around Lake Chiuta and Chilwa)

Expect mild conditions tonight and hazy during morning. Sunny and very hot conditions during the afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Ngabu Min.17°C and Max.35°C

SOUTHERN HIGHLANDS (Shire highlands, Kirk Range up to Dedza)

Cool and hazy conditions tonight and during morning. Sunny and hot in the afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Blantyre Min.15°C and Max.28°C

<u>CENTRAL AREAS</u> (Lilongwe, Mchinji, Ntchisi, Dowa, Kasungu and part of Mzimba District) Expect very cold conditions tonight and tomorrow morning. Hot conditions to persist in the afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Lilongwe Min.09°C and Max.28°C

LAKESHORE AREAS (Mangochi, Salima, Nkhotakota, Nkhata Bay, Likoma, Karonga) Cool conditions tonight and hazy during morning. Sunny and hot during the afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Mangochi Min. 15°C and Max.31°C

NORTHERN AREAS (all areas in the north except lakeshore)

Cold conditions tonight and tomorrow morning. Sunny and warm conditions during the afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Mzuzu Min. 11°C and Max.24°C

WIND: Generally easterlies...
