WEATHER FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND TOMORROW 15TH AUGUST, 2024
SYNOPSIS AND INFERENCE:

Expect windy, sunny and occasionally dusty conditions due to the influence of warm and moderate air mass from the Indian Ocean.

WARNING: Moderate Mwera winds will blow on Lake Malawi, Lake Chilwa and other lake water bodies starting from tomorrow night on 15 August 2024, and are likely to weaken by Saturday evening. Therefore, lake users are advised to take all the necessary precautionary measures to avoid loss of life and property.

SHIRE VALLEY (areas along Shire River and around Lake Chiuta and Chilwa)
Expect mild conditions tonight and tomorrow morning. Windy, occasionally dusty, sunny and hot conditions in the afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Ngabu Min.20°C and Max.35°C

SOUTHERN HIGHLANDS (Shire highlands, Kirk Range up to Dedza)
Cool conditions tonight and tomorrow morning. Windy, occasionally dusty, sunny and hot conditions in the afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Blantyre Min.14°C and Max.28°C

CENTRAL AREAS (Lilongwe, Mchinji, Ntchisi, Dowa, Kasungu and part of Mzimba District)
Expect cold conditions tonight and during morning. Sunny and hot conditions during the afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Lilongwe Min.12°C and Max.28°C

LAKESHORE AREAS (Mangochi, Salima, Nkhotakota, Nkhata Bay, Likoma, Karonga)
Cool conditions tonight and tomorrow morning. Sunny, hazy and hot conditions during the afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Mangochi Min. 18°C and Max.31°C

NORTHERN AREAS (all areas in the north except lakeshore)
Expect very cold conditions tonight and tomorrow morning. Warm conditions during the afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Mzuzu Min. 08°C and Max.26°C

WINDS: Easterlies becoming South easterlies...
