SUMMARY OF WEATHER AHEAD

Expect occasional thunderstorms associated with rain of varying intensity due to the influence of the Inter-Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) coupled with a slight influx of Congo air mass. Isolated cases of **Flash Floods** are also anticipated.

WEATHER DURING PAST WEEK

Many areas experienced a substantial amount of rain. Below are maps illustrating some of the rainfall recorded last week.

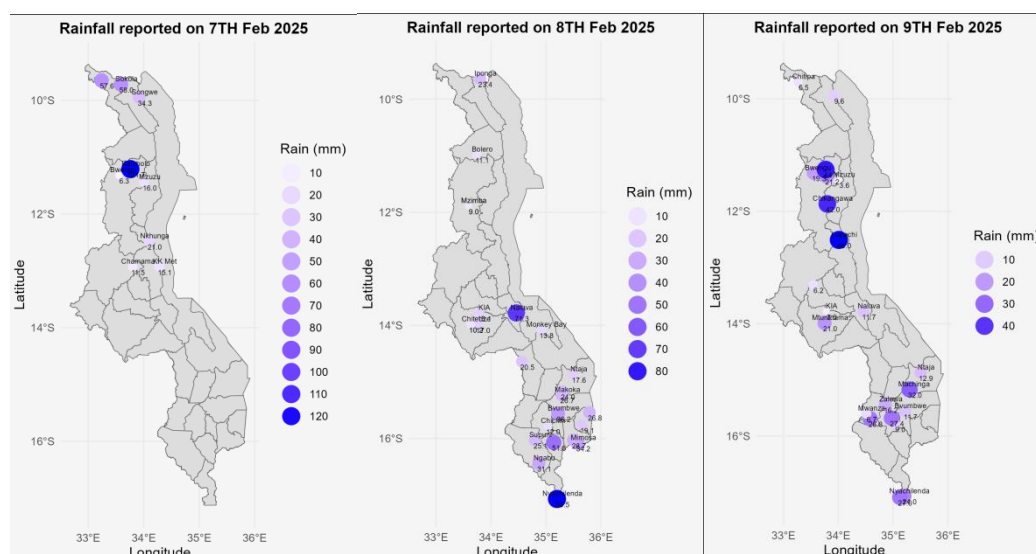


Fig: Shows some of the rainfall reported from 7TH to 9TH February, 2025

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- **Flash floods:** Stay alert and avoid crossing flooded or fast flowing water to keep safe.
- **Thunderstorms:** Avoid being outside during thunderstorms. Seek shelter in a safe building and keep away from open areas, tall trees, and metal structures.
- **Wetness:** Be watchful of overly wet structures, such as **houses and toilets** that could collapse unexpectedly.
