WEATHER FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND TOMORROW 22ND MARCH 2025 SYNOPSIS AND INFERENCE:

Expect isolated thunderstorms with rain, mainly over parts of the North, due to the influence of the equatorial rain belt. Mwera winds are also expected to weaken by Saturday evening 22ND March, 2025.

SHIRE VALLEY (areas along Shire River and around Lake Chiuta and Chilwa)

Expect generally warm conditions tonight and tomorrow morning. Expect partly cloudy and hot weather tomorrow afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Ngabu Min.24°C and Max.33°C

SOUTHERN HIGHLANDS (Shire highlands, Kirk Range up to Dedza i.e. Ntcheu, Neno, Mwanza, Mulanje, Thyolo, Zomba, Chiradzulu, Phalombe and Blantyre)

Cool conditions with fog patches tonight and tomorrow morning. Expect cloudy and warm weather with chance of isolated showers tomorrow afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Blantyre Min.18°C and Max.26°C

CENTRAL AREAS (Lilongwe, Mchinji, Ntchisi, Dowa, Kasungu and part of Mzimba District)

Expect cool conditions tonight and tomorrow morning. Partly cloudy and warm conditions with chance of isolated showers tomorrow afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Lilongwe Min.17°C and Max.28°C

LAKESHORE AREAS (Mangochi, Salima, Nkhotakota, Nkhata Bay, Likoma, Karonga)

Expect cloudy conditions with isolated thunderstorms accompanied by rain mainly over the north tonight tomorrow morning. Cloudy with isolated thunderstorms mainly over north tomorrow afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Mangochi Min. 22°C and Max.29°C

NORTHERN AREAS (all areas in the north except lakeshore)

Expect cool conditions with rain over few areas tonight and tomorrow morning. **Cloudy warm conditions with isolated rain** tomorrow afternoon.

Forecast Temperatures: Mzuzu Min. 16°C and Max.25°C

WINDS: Variable but gusty in stormy areas...
